# Faculty Service Day

Bellarmino Faculty and Staff Begin School Year in Service to Others

Bellarmino College Preparatory faculty and staff began the 2013-2014 school year by providing service to a variety of community agencies in the South Bay.

Each year, faculty and staff are invited to participate in community service on a day during the week in which school begins, and so it was on August 20 when 106 volunteers from the Bellarmine community provided service to local agencies, which included HOPE Services, the Lupus Foundation, Sacred Heart Community Service, Second Harvest Food Bank, Services for Brain Injury, and the Lupus Foundation. In addition, many faculty and staff worked in the Bellarmine Garden, which provides fresh fruit and vegetables harvested and donated to both Second Harvest Food Bank and Sacred Heart Community Service.

"As members of the Bellarmine community, we are called to live according to a pattern of service modeled by Jesus Christ," said Mr. Steve Pinkston, the school's Director of Christian Service. "Our hope is that each member of our student body, faculty, and staff uses his critical skills to help bring about a more just world; to bring about the Kingdom of God." Mr. Pinkston also noted that the 106 volunteers from Bellarmine represented the highest number of participants in its Faculty/Staff Service Day in the past ten years.

The day began with a prayer service, followed by community service at the agencies, and concluded with a Liturgy in the Leontyne Chapel on the Bellarmine campus.

Most of the agencies chosen for the faculty and staff community service day are among those also served by Bellarmine students throughout the year.

# Ron Caragher '85 Chalk Talk

The Bellarmine College Preparatory Dads of Grads group invited Ron Caragher '85 back to Bellarmine for a "Chalk Talk" about his life and career. The event was held the evening of September 11 in the Sobrato Center for Humanities and the Arts.

Now the head football coach at San Jose State University, Caragher spoke extensively on his experiences and the values that have remained close to him throughout his life. Caragher used his coaching job to model and give examples for many of these values, and spoke inspirationally to an audience of more than 300, including many members of the Bellarmine football teams who attended.

Caragher's most important and most emphasized philosophy was that of purpose, and the effects of it. Coach Caragher said that without purpose, a football player, a student, or any person's role in life has little value to society. He believes that whatever one does in life, one should want to do it and find purpose in the job.

Caragher also holds close to his heart the importance of character. As a coach, accountability is very important to him, and he stated that he would much rather have an accountable, mediocre player than an unaccountable star player. He thinks that challenges and challenging times are useful, and should be seen as opportunities for growth.

Coach Caragher's final point was that excellence is not so much a condition as it is an attitude, and he feels that student-athletes are held to higher standards than other students.

# From the Principal's Office



For each of the past five years, Bellarmine has selected a justice topic upon which to focus for the year. Past topics have been: hunger, environmental sustainability, immigration, and restorative justice. This year, with input from students and a number of faculty members, we have selected the theme of masculinity.

At first blush, this topic certainly seems to be significantly different from its predecessors. In some ways, it is. While students have enjoyed the first several topics, one common concern that we heard from them regularly was something along the lines of, "Okay, I understand that's a problem. But what can I do about it?" In some cases, students grappled with the topics on an intellectual level, but perhaps less so personally. We wanted to select a topic this year that would hit closer to home for everyone. Every teenage male, at one point or another, struggles with the question of what it means to be a man. The guiding question we have chosen for ourselves this year is, "Who is the man God has called me to be?"

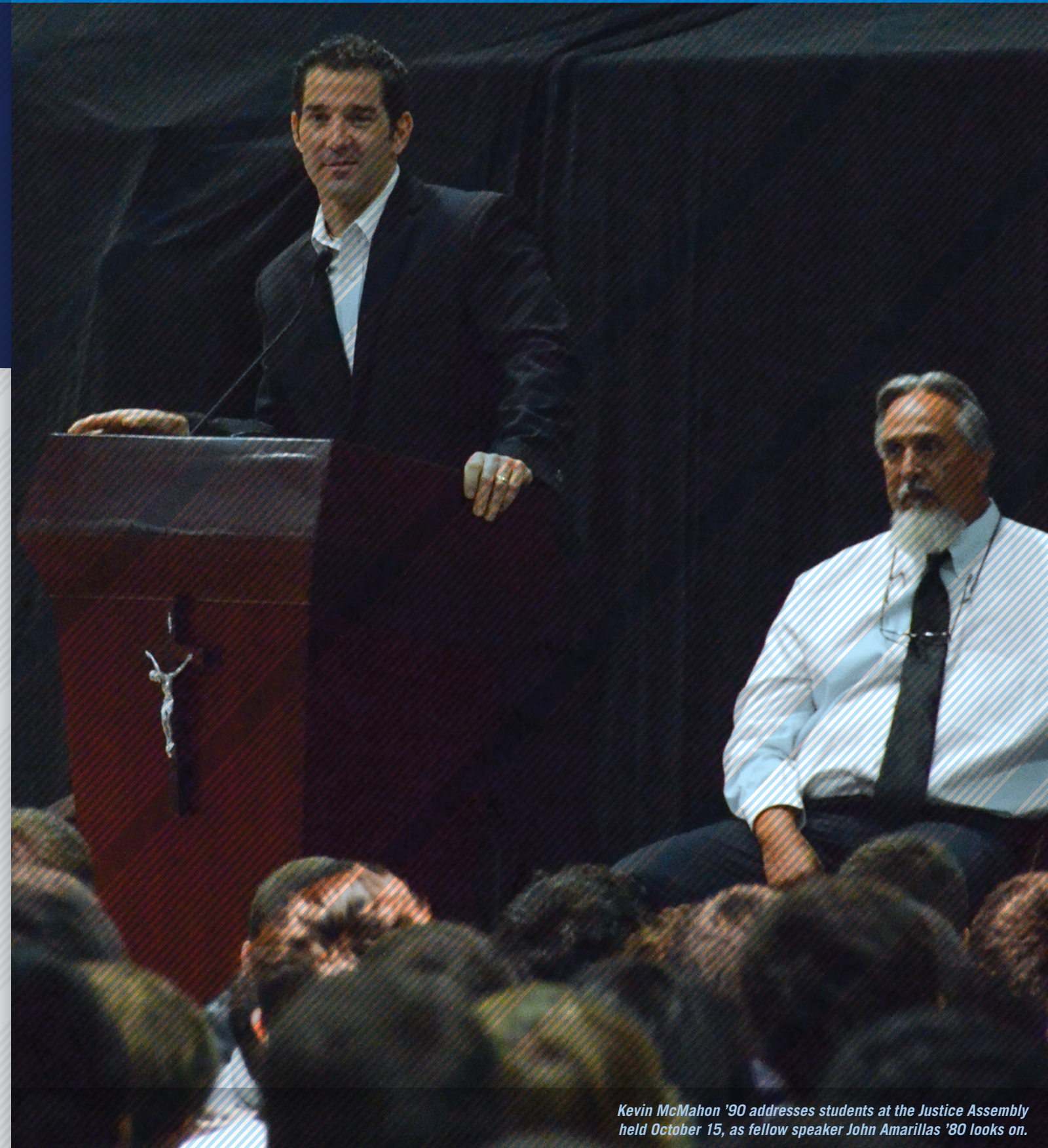
As we seek answers to this question, we will first examine some of the many answers that pop culture provides. When we surveyed students about the words or images they associate with masculinity, nearly every answer had to do with strength or power. Words like "strong," "muscles," "tough," "athletic," and "brave" were the most common responses. When we asked what movies they associated with masculinity, each one of the most common answers was a violent film (Rambo, Terminator, James Bond, Batman, The Expendables and Braveheart were the most common answers). Even "buddy comedies" were pretty far down on the list.

I know that our students are savvy enough not just to accept what Hollywood is trying to sell them wholesale. But I also know when these influences are so pervasive, they can't help but have an impact. Forty-eight percent of our students said they wished they were more manly frequently or sometimes, and 69% indicated it is very or somewhat important for them to look manly.

At an all-school assembly in October, we began the process of trying to de-bunk some of these myths of what it means to be a man. Mr. Kevin McMahon '90, a Bellarmine fine arts teacher and two-time Olympian, shared about how his thinking has evolved from his teenage understanding of himself as one who needed to be a conqueror – of other men, of women, and of pain – to his current understanding of being a man for and with others. And Mr. John Amarillas '80 talked about how his dad brought him up to be a stoic, to be a person who always had to keep his feelings inside. John shared how as he has grown, he has learned the need to express his emotions and feelings, and what that has done for him as father, teacher, and coach.

So where do we go from here? We want to expand students' understanding of what it means to be a man, and we want them to understand that being a man is not an inherently good or bad thing. What is much more important is the kind of man they choose to be. We hope to equip students with the knowledge that being strong isn't dictated by the size of their physique, but can also be demonstrated by their strength of character and their emotional strength. We hope that they will understand how important it is that they treat women and other men with respect and kindness. And we hope that they will understand that they have the capacity to make a real difference in their world by being a "man for and with others."

# Cunningham HONOR

Legendary Bellarmine Coach Named to San Jose Sports Hall of Fame



Longtime Bellarmine College Preparatory baseball coach Gary Cunningham is among this year's inductees into the San Jose Sports Hall of Fame, becoming only the fifth prep coach and first baseball coach to be so honored.

Cunningham, who remains a Bellarmine staff member, retired from his position as the school's head baseball coach in 2008 after taking the Bells to nine West Catholic Athletic League titles. His teams won the CCS Championship three times and had an overall win-loss record of 526-185. In addition to having the privilege of coaching his sons Kevin, Kelly and Patrick, Cunningham coached several Major League Baseball players including Kevin Frandsen, who currently plays for the Philadelphia Phillies; Tommy Medica, who is currently playing for the San Diego Padres; and Pat Burrell, who earned a World Series title with the San Francisco Giants.

"Gary has been a remarkable coach in the South Bay for decades, and we were

blessed to have him coach our teams at Bellarmine for more than two decades," said Chris Meyercord, Bellarmine's principal. "He is beloved by players and fellow coaches alike for his terrific sportsmanship, his deep knowledge of the game, and for always making sure that baseball remains fun. He is truly deserving of this accolade."

Mike West, Bellarmine's athletic director, adds, "Gary's career accomplishments speak for themselves, but it's his charisma and positive energy that made him such a

fantastic coach. Gary's leadership of our baseball program was a true blessing for our school community."

Among Cunningham's other honors are being inducted into the San Jose State Baseball Hall of Fame in 1994; CCS Honor Coach for Baseball in 2006; American Baseball Coaches Association Regional Coach of the Year in 2006; California Coaches Association Baseball Coach of the Year in 2007; Santa Clara County Hot Stove Lifetime Achievement Award winner in 2009; San Jose State University Lifetime Achievement Award in 2009; and Bellarmine College Preparatory Athletic Hall of Fame inductee in 2012.

"I was utterly speechless when I was informed that I was going to be inducted into the San Jose Sports Hall of Fame, and those who know me will find that hard to believe," said Cunningham in response to this recognition. "This honor belongs to all the players I had the great pleasure to coach, and to all the coaches that I enjoyed working with during my 38 years of coaching."

Other honorees inducted into the San Jose Sports Hall of Fame, presented by the San Jose Sports Authority at its November 20 event at SAP Center in San Jose, are former Stanford and 49ers' quarterback Frankie Albert, ex-pro soccer star Paul Child, and Stanford women's basketball and Olympic coach Tara VanDerveer.

Mary remained dedicated to the students, employees and parents of Bellarmine. Whether on the phone or in person, she always had a kind word and positive attitude.”

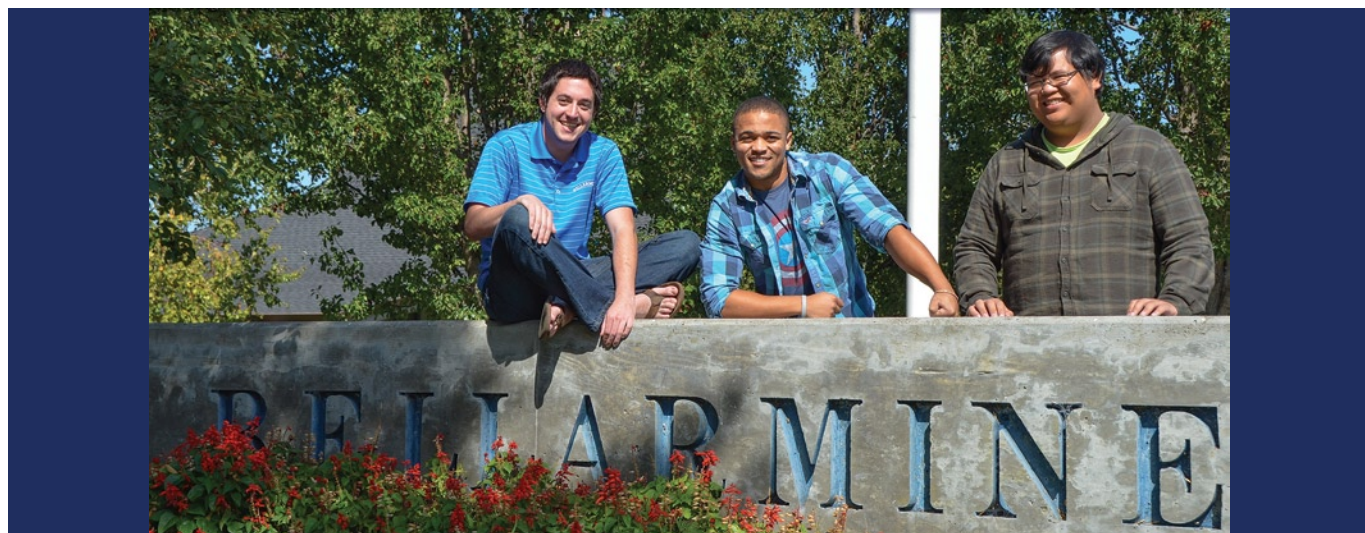

## Time Capsule

Kostka Hall, once known as the Helen Guth Building when the campus site was occupied by College of the Pacific, was renamed in honor of St. Stanislaus Kostka, a Polish novice of the Society of Jesus. For some time, it was the main residence for boarders, and was remodeled in 1966 to allow additional classrooms. The building was razed in the mid-1980s to allow for construction of the James A. Carney Science Center.

# The Call to Spirituality

I welcome this opportunity to write this piece in our Annual Report of Giving to underscore the quality and expansiveness of the education in which we are engaged at Bellarmine. In particular, I want to stress that we are about the education of the full person.

The positive feature of our students is their determination to discover many facets of life including an understanding of who they are, and who they are becoming. Their pursuit of science, literature, history, art, religion, and math opens them up to a realm of reality that they never have penetrated before, through the lens of young adult eyes. To experiment in chemistry, biology, botany and physics opens chapters in their grasp of life and how there is such an interconnectedness of its components. To begin to explore the molecular world is to enter into another theater of life that speaks of wonder! In our education, too, they examine the depth of insights of writers who can lead them to the wondrous discovery of relationships with all its inherent emotions. Again in the other disciplines, they begin to assemble other perspectives on the human race, its interactions and its ability to create beauty and insight.

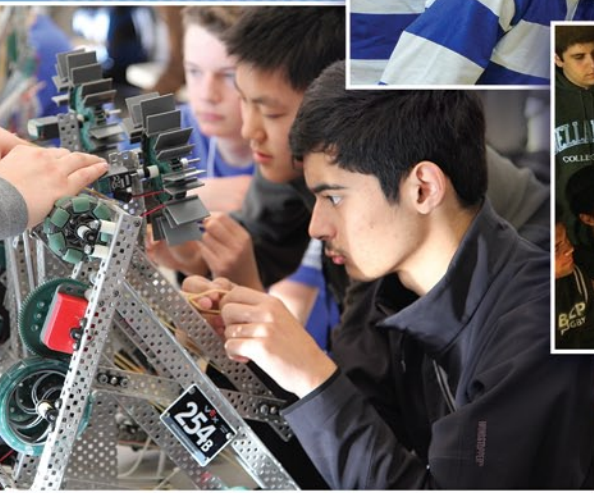
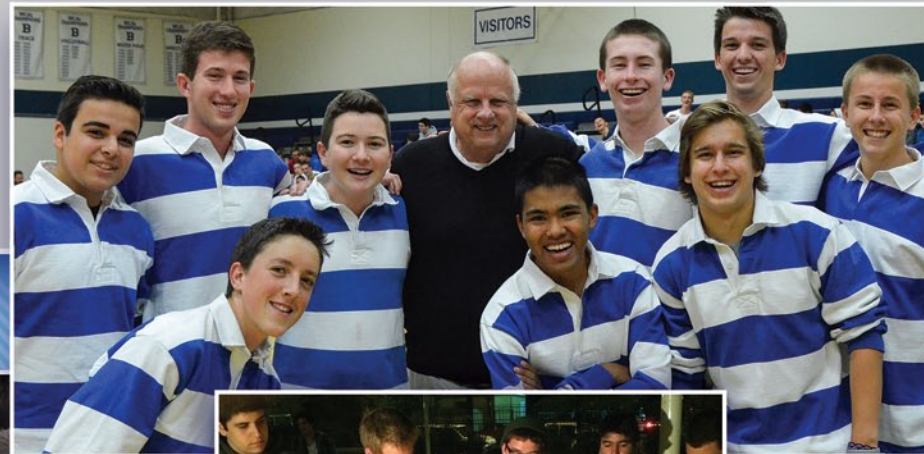
Having laid a basic perspective on the disciplines presented in the classroom, I want to expand on our overall education by concentrating on the spiritual development of our young men. It is not unusual for a good portion of our world to de-emphasize the spiritual component in our make-up. For years, I taught how the ancient Greek philosophers realized this side of reality and were drawn to it. Yet, because it is not as visible to the passerby, it is often not nourished.

At Bellarmine, we form a community of young men from many cultures and religious traditions. Yet, when you call them into conversations about the Spirit of God alive in their lives, they respond readily to the subject.

I have witnessed this level of exchange during many evenings of reflection attached to our Immersion trips, on retreats, on planning meetings for Eucharistic celebrations, in class and with my Presidential Ambassadors. Within this realm, our young men examine and articulate their "faith journey" or their attempts to discover the existence of a "higher being." Their earnestness and dedication to this quest comes across in a variety of ways through exchanges in the classroom, conversations with adults, and through dialogue with members of Campus Ministry.

Another emphasis at Bellarmine is to have our students embrace silence and reflection. I don't know how often this has been stressed in addresses, homilies, letters to families and guidance by teachers. Silence can unravel the dynamic of God's Spirit, encouraging the soul to embrace prayer, generosity and a moral lifestyle which brings inner peace and joy.

At graduation I am convinced that so many of our men will continue to search for truth, to undertake studies and experiences of worth and to compassionately respond to the needs of others. They have been called to an adulthood that praises God, to a lifestyle of being a "man for others" and to "a faith that does justice." They know that Bellarmine is a family – their family – and that its members vigorously exercise the Jesuit tradition of "cura personalis" (the care of the individual). They have been challenged intellectually to make sense of creation, its purpose, its end. Not all will call God, God, but their inclination is to embrace the search for meaning. It is indeed a Jesuit education. It is indeed a journey worth taking!

## Financial Aid Program

Bellarmino's Financial Aid Program continues to play a vital role in maintaining the school's diversity, as well as ensuring that all qualified candidates are able to enroll and continue at Bellarmine regardless of financial circumstances. During the 2012-13 school year, Bellarmine awarded \$3.6 million in financial aid, with nearly a quarter of our students receiving tuition assistance. The funds needed to provide Bellarmine's unparalleled financial aid come through fundraising efforts for Direct Financial Aid, and partially from the Financial Aid Endowment. Below is a breakdown of how those funds were awarded based on a percentage of tuition covered. Tuition for the 2012-13 school year was \$16,770.

## 2012 President's Award Marc Rebboah

Marc Rebboah was honored with the 2012 President's Award for his leadership, integrity, his goodness, and commitment to Bellarmine College Preparatory and our mission.

Marc Rebboah personifies the motto of being a "Man for Others." The inspirational story of his family leaving war-torn Algiers during his childhood in search of a better life, and his subsequent success in school and business, directly tie back to the Jesuits, to whom Marc gives much credit for providing support to the entire family. "They took a genuine interest in every person and brought out the uniqueness in each," said Marc recently from his Los Gatos office at Enterprise Trust & Investment Company, California's only fully independent Trust company, of which he is Founder, President and CEO.

These same attributes may be said of Marc, whose reputation, both personally and professionally, is second to none. "It all started at Bellarmine," he said, noting that having been a financial aid recipient, and a hard worker, provided opportunities that allowed him to succeed in the classroom and on the football field. He became both a member of the Northern California High School Football Hall of Fame and awarded Academic All-American his senior year, and upon graduating from Bellarmine in 1977, continued his Jesuit education at Santa Clara University on a football scholarship. He went on to be inducted into the Bellarmine Athletic Hall of Fame in 1992.

Among his biggest influences, Marc cites men such as former Bellarmine president and principal, Father Robert Mathewson, S.J., who "believed in me," as well as legendary Bellarmine football coach John Hanna and former dean of students Don Ardisson, both of whom Marc said had an "incredible impact on my development."

Mindful that he has benefitted from the generosity of many over the years, foremost among them the perseverance of his parents, Marc consistently gives back, serving others in many ways, particularly through supporting the apostolate of Catholic education. He is the Chairman of the Bellarmine Board of Trustees; is immediate past-chairman of its Board of Regents; former chairman of the Bellarmine Development Committee, which has been instrumental in the success of the Campaign for the 21st Century; member of Bellarmine's Budget and Investment Committee; and chaired the school's successful Campaign for the Endowments. Marc is also a member of the Santa Clara University Board of Regents, served as a cabinet member of Bishop Patrick J. McGrath's Endowment and Capital Campaign, was co-chair of the Development Campaign that raised the financial resources to build Holy Spirit School, and is co-founder of the Bishop's Circle of Excellence that raises perpetual funding to support those less fortunate within the Diocese of San Jose. Additionally, organizations with which Marc is or has been affiliated include the Association of Independent Trust Companies and American Bankers, Children's Discovery Museum Board of Directors and Legal/Finance Committee, Santa Clara Valley YMCA Endowment Investment Committee, Rotary Club of San Jose Endowment Board of Trustees, Catholic Charities Planned Giving Council, and San Jose Symphony Foundation Board of Trustees.

Marc's wife of 24 years, Terry, shares his passion for community involvement. While a parent at Bellarmine, Terry was active with the Mothers' Guild and continues to be engaged with the Bellarmine community as a member of AMEN (Alumni Mothers Extended Network). Terry is also involved with the American Cancer Society's Relay for Life, and is a mentor for Students Rising Above, which invests in low income, first generation college students who have demonstrated a deep commitment to education and strength of character in overcoming tremendous odds of poverty, homelessness and neglect.

Marc and Terry are proud parents of two sons, who follow in their father's footsteps as Bellarmine alumni and by continuing their Jesuit educations. Brandon, Bellarmine Class of 2009, is a graduate of Santa Clara University, where he was a Communication major, and is looking forward to attending law school; and Justin, Bellarmine Class of 2011, a student at Regis University in Denver, Colorado, studying Visual Communication/Graphic Design.

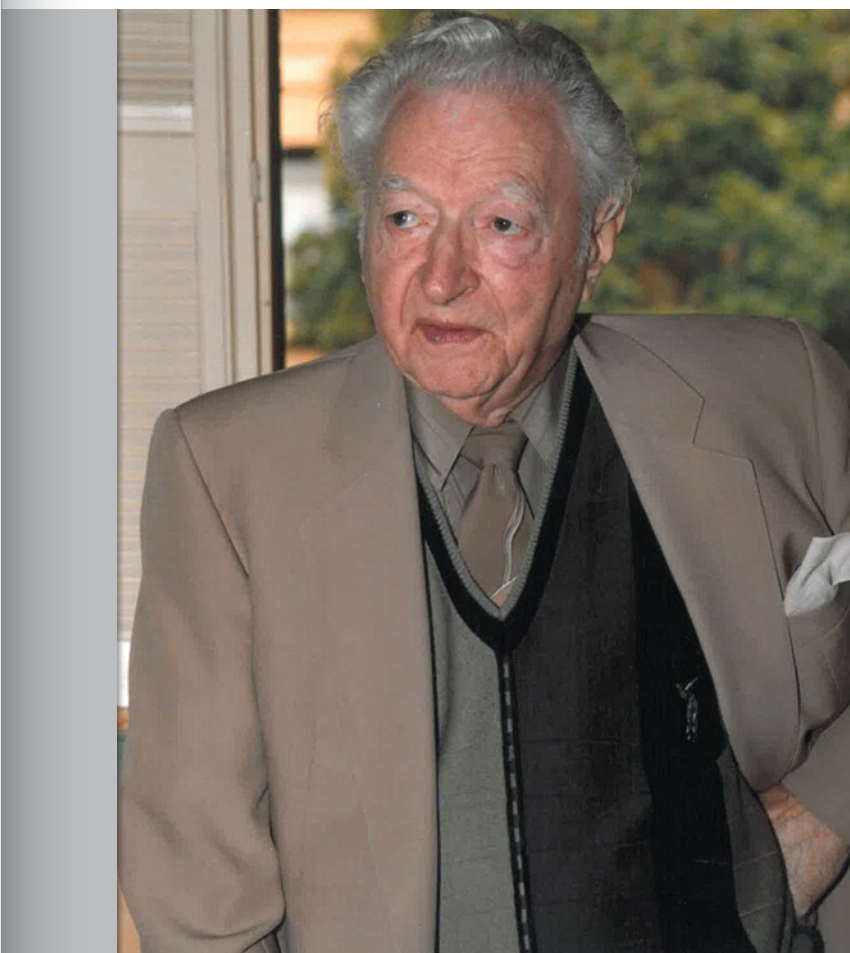

## Major Benefactor & Longtime Friend of Bellarmine, Harold J. DeLuca, Leaves a Legacy



Mr. Harold J. DeLuca, a graduate of St. Ignatius College Preparatory, Class of 1929, and Santa Clara University, Class of 1933, passed away on November 30, 2011 at 99 years of age. He was the son of the late Amerigo and Adelaide DeLuca, and was predeceased by his brother, Robert DeLuca '36, in whose memory Bellarmine dedicated a second floor wing of the recently constructed Lorry I. Lokey Academic Center.

Harold was proud of his Jesuit roots and lived his life in the Jesuit tradition of being "A Man for Others." Upon college graduation, he began his business career with BJ Holmes International, a venerable poultry trading company, where he remained until founding Lehar Sales Company in 1949. During his long career in the poultry industry, Harold founded and nurtured a myriad of companies engaged in nearly every facet of poultry production and distribution. Both he and Lehar Sales Company enjoyed a national reputation for honesty, integrity, performance, and sound business principles. He was a mentor to countless people in the industry who sought guidance and wisdom.

Harold's greatest legacy, however, lay not in commerce, but in the world of philanthropy. To Harold, life had little meaning unless one shared his or her success with those less fortunate. During his lifetime he donated most of his personal wealth to charities too numerous to mention individually.

Harold was especially proud of providing all of the funding for the Leontyne Chapel on Bellarmine's campus in memory of his sister, Leontyne, and his parents. Many of his gifts were given anonymously, and he gave

from his heart with no desire for personal recognition. He was a man of great warmth, caring, and personal honor.

Harold had many friends who were priests or nuns and lay people in countless Catholic charities, contributing to their causes. Fr. Jerry Wade, S.J. '55 and Ron Pine '57 of Bellarmine were close friends of Harold for more than 35 years. Harold was especially generous to Bellarmine by not only the gift of the Leontyne Chapel but also through a significant gift in his will, life estates in real property and life income gifts, just to name a few. His Lyda & Rico DeLuca Family Foundation, founded by his mother and father, since the early 1960s had been, and continues to this day, supporting the Direct Financial Aid Fund for the benefit of families of students who have a demonstrated need of tuition assistance.

In both business and philanthropy, Harold DeLuca was a visionary and one who led by example with the hope that his gifts would provide lifelong benefits to the school and those it serves.

**BOB TRINCHERO '58** reports that he and his wife, Patricia, recently returned from six weeks in Italy. They spent two



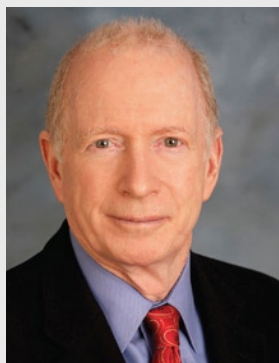
